Getting Here
from Downtown

Take Douglas Street North. This turns into the Trans Canada Hwy.1. Take Exit 10 towards View Royal/Colwood. At the “y” junction, stay left and follow this through onto Sooke Rd. Approximately 3 km on your left you will see the entrance sign for Hatley Park National Historic Site, home of Royal Roads University. Drive down the hill to below the castle to park in Lot 3. You will need to purchase a ticket from the machine in the parking lot to display on the dash of your car. Alternately, take BC Transit bus #14 on Douglas St. and Yates St. transferring to bus #39 on Helmcken which brings you to the entrance of Hatley Park @ 2005 Sooke Rd. \$2 /senior.
